Comparison institutions were selected from an initial list of 60 private Doctoral Research Universities and Great Lakes region institutions that offer masters degrees, and selected Seventh-day Adventist institutions, all of similar size. The list was trimmed by eliminating those institutions with

- No doctoral degree programs
- Less than 10% of undergraduates are full-time, first-time degree/certificate seeking
- 25th percentile averages over 500 on SAT critical thinking & math and over 22 on the ACT composite; or no reported averages for SAT or ACT
