Severe food shortages caused by drought have burdened southern Madagascar. The 20 Seventh-day Adventist churches in southern Madagascar made up of 495 families and over 1691 individuals, are facing severe famine.

A gift of \$75 can feed a family of four for one month. In addition to covering staple items such as beans, rice, oil, salt, water, and hygiene products, we are working to help families build a sustainable source of income by supporting micro-enterprises in trade and farming.
