AWARDS CRITERIA

Daniel A. Augsburger Excellence in Teaching Award

This award is intended to recognize faculty whose teaching reflects the high standards of excellence modeled by Dr. Augsburger in his 60 years of teaching at Andrews University. Dr. Augsburger's leadership, academic rigor, breadth of knowledge, teacher-scholar role, along with care and concern for students, exemplify the best of faculty endeavors. Faculty, staff or students may nominate candidates for this award. The Daniel Augsburger Excellence in Teaching Award committee selects the award recipients based on rigorous criteria and evidence provided by the nominees. The committee is comprised of three past award recipients, two members of the Effective Teaching and Learning Council, and one member of the administration. This is a surprise award although faculty nominated are aware of their nomination. Being nominated is in itself a great recognition.

Faith Engagement Award

Awarded to any employee, faculty or staff who has a culture of faith engagement and demonstrates a strong influence and caring attitude to a broad section of students as well as to fellow employees. Nominations from the Center for Faith Engagement Committee are considered and voted by the Council on University Honors & Awards. Instituted in 2005. *This is a surprise award*.

Staff Excellence in Service Award

Recipients of this award are hourly or salaried full- or part-time staff who have served for at least three consecutive years, and have not previously received the award. The award is given "in recognition of outstanding service to the University, the church, and the community, and for demonstrating, by precept and example, a Christ-centered life." This is a surprise award.


Siegfried H. Horn Excellence in Research & Creative Scholarship Award

This award was established in 2011 to honor Siegfried Horn's legacy of scholarship and contribution to the field of biblical archaeology at Andrews University, and his impact upon the world church and the wider community of scholars. This award has been established to recognize the lifetime scholarship achievement of Andrews University faculty members. Nominated from each of four categories by the chair of the Scholarly Research Council, and selected by the membership of this council, recipients must be associate or full professors, and full-time employees for a minimum of five years. *This is a surprise award*.

J.N. Andrews Service Award

This is the second year for the J.N. Andrews Service Award. The award is intended to recognize the value of individuals on our campus who are employed by outside organizations and provide an essential support service for Andrews University. Candidates were nominated by a campus-wide process using a Class Climate ballot. *This is a surprise award*.
