- An email notification will be sent when your order is ready for pickup or when it ships.

FERPA

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974



The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. Students will need to give electronic authorization before staff are able to discuss account matters with others, parents & sponsors included.

PAYMENT PLANS



3% REBATE PLAN-YEAR IN ADVANCE

Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the full year by August 15 to receive a 3% rebate. To receive rebate, email payments@andrews.edu after payment is made.

1% REBATE PLAN-SEMESTER IN ADVANCE

• Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses in full for the semester and receive a 1% rebate. To receive rebate, email payments@andrews.edu after payment is made.

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

- Arrange to make monthly payments toward estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the semester.
- Sum of monthly payment plan not to exceed 40% of semester's estimated out-of-pocket expenses.
- Late payments will incur a late fee of \$25.
- A 1% carrying charge will be posted for any unpaid balance aged 30 days.
